Dear Parent and Student:

Attached is an information packet to register for a Sussex County Community College Concurrent Course. For a complete listing of our Concurrent Courses, please see the attached Concurrent Enrollment Program Chart.

Taking a concurrent course and receiving college credits while still in high school is a great opportunity to get a jump-start on college. However, not all colleges will accept the credits. It is the student's responsibility to check with the college(s) he or she is interested in to see if they will accept concurrent credits from SCCC.

Upon passing the required testing (Accuplacer – College Level Math) and successfully completing the course, you will receive a transcript of grades from SCCC. It is your responsibility to forward this transcript to the college(s) of your choice. The grade for the class will appear on the KRHS transcript, but there will be no designation that it was a concurrent course at SCCC. The class grade will apply to overall high school GPA, rank and graduation requirements.

Concurrent Application Process:

Step 1: New Concurrent Students must apply to SCCC by **November 1, 2022** (*Please skip to step 2 if you already have an SCCC ID from previous concurrent coursework*):

1. Visit www.sussex.edu/admissions
2. Click "Apply Online"
3. Complete the online form
4. For "Admission Status" select "Concurrent Enrollment Program"
5. Submit Application

You will receive your SCCC ID number and portal access within two weeks

Step 2: ALL students (*new and returning*) must complete the Concurrent Request Form on the Guidance Website prior to **November 1, 2022**. ***Failure to do so will result in your application being denied***

Step 3: Once your application has been processed, you will be notified via email if you are required to take Accuplacer-College Level Math (CLM) by **December 20, 2022**.

- Students required to the CLM at SCCC must do so by **December 20, 2020**. Students can schedule a time by calling the Testing Center at 973-300-2155.
- Please provide a copy of your passing score to Mrs. Morelli. Upon successful completion of this test, the student will be approved to register for the course(s).

Step 4: Students & parents/guardians will be contacted directly by SCCC for course registration and online payment. Registration paperwork and tuition will be due in January/February 2023.
