- There are approximately 800 students at KRHS in grades 7 through 12.
- Our school is comprised on students from 4 sending districts:

  - McKeown Elementary (Hampton)
  - Stillwater Township
- Classes are mixed with students from all 4 districts.















# Bell Schedules




