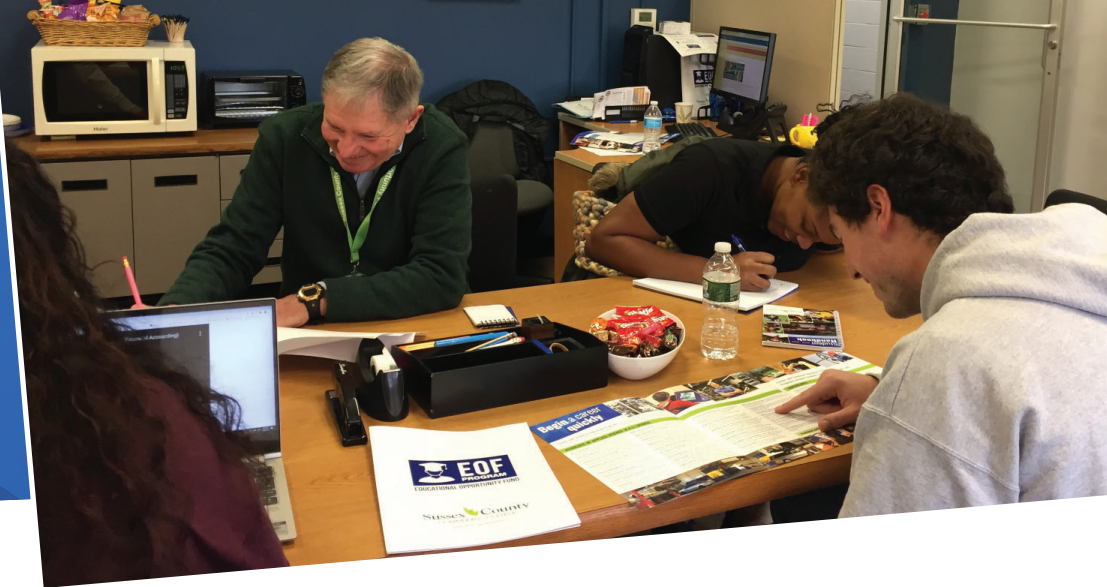

Summer Bridge Program

This free program offers first-time students an opportunity to get a head start on their college education. The program is designed to ease the academic, social, and emotional transition from high school to college. Upon completion, students will have an individualized academic plan and be registered for their first semester at Sussex.

One-on-One Counseling

All EOF scholars will receive one-on-one counseling during the semester to discuss their academic progress and/or other issues affecting their educational success. Students will meet with an EOF counselor to create an academic plan and register for courses; enabling them to follow a well-defined plan toward successful degree completion.

Academic Coaching

Students have access to the Writing Center and Math coaches for additional help.

Career Counseling

EOF scholars can explore various careers through workshops and Campus sponsored activities.

Graduate Transfer Advisement

The EOF program provides transfer advisement for all EOF scholars preparing to transfer after graduation.

Financial Aid

The EOF Grant supplements the State Tuition Aid Grant (TAG). This Grant helps further defray the costs of a college education.

What does the EOF Program expect of me?

- All EOF scholars are required to meet with their EOF Counselor during the semester to discuss academic progress and/or issues affecting their educational success.
- Attend tutoring as required.
- Attend scheduled workshops and activities.
- Maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA.

EOF Admission Requirements:

1. Students must have a high school diploma, a high school equivalency certificate, or take the High School Equivalency Test.
2. Students are required to be residents of New Jersey for a minimum of one year prior to attending.
3. Complete a Sussex County Community College EOF Admission Application.
4. Complete the Financial Aid application at studentaid.gov. **Sussex school code: 025688**
5. Schedule an EOF interview.
