

KITTATINNY JUNIOR HIGH SUMMER SCHOOL APPLICATION FOR THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR

Session Runs: *Monday, June 28, 2021 – Thursday, August 5, 2021*

The Kittatinny Regional High School Junior High Summer School has been designed to assist our students with meeting all curriculum requirements needed to pass courses failed during the school year. There is a cost of \$300.00 for each course at the expense of the parent or guardian. Checks should be made out to KRHS and paid on or before the first class session.

REVIEW WORK: To make up a failure, a minimum of 130 minutes daily instruction is required in addition to outside preparation. Two major subjects shall be considered a maximum workload.

COURSES OFFERED: English, Literature Reading, Social Studies, Mathematics, or Science

REGISTRATION: Registration forms must be completed and handed in to the Main Office on either a Monday or Wednesday from 11 am - 1 pm. Please make sure all paperwork is addressed to either Mrs. Falchetta or Mrs. Lasso along with the payment for Summer School in check form. Registration opens on June 2nd. The paperwork could also be scanned and emailed to klasso@krhs.net or sfalchet@krhs.net as well. **Last day to register is Thursday, June 24.**

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. Students will be admitted to the program upon completion of the registration form.
2. Payment must be received on or before the first day of class.
3. Only failed courses may be taken.
4. Students will be responsible for their own transportation.

SUMMER SCHOOL REGULATIONS

1. ATTENDANCE:

- A. Summer School courses progress through a great deal of subject matter in a relatively short time. **Absences, more than one day, without medical documentation are prohibited and will lead to retention in the current grade.**
- B. Parental note required for first absence. Second absence - **medical documentation required. Please note: Absences even with medical documentation MUST be made up.**
- C. Tardiness is a serious matter; two tardies will be the **maximum** permitted. The third tardy will be considered 1 day absent.
- D. All students desiring credit for specific courses must take final examinations.
- E. Students must not arrive more than **10 minutes** prior to class and should be picked up no later than **10 minutes** after class.

2. HOMEWORK: Given daily and must be completed.

3. CONDUCT:

- A. Students are expected to follow rules of good conduct, as stated in the Kittatinny Regional High School Student Handbook.
- B. Dress must be appropriate and in accordance with the student dress code. Footwear must be worn at all times.
- C. Violations of any and all school rules and regulations may result in disciplinary action.

4. GRADES: Final grades will not be released until all academic and financial obligations are met.
